#### **PRINCIPAL'S WELCOME**

#### Welcome from our Principal, Mr Eldon Dear Parents and Carers,



The summer term at Manchester Academy was one of the most memorable in my time at the school – unfortunately this was not because of the weather which was often damp! In many ways the summer term is dominated by the GCSE examinations processes which now take place over two months. This year the GCSE grade boundaries returned to pre-COVID levels which made earning the grades even harder than before. I am so proud to report that we achieved our best ever results and the progress our students made will make Manchester Academy one of the top performing schools in the city.

There were so many opportunities for our students across the Academy – both in school and outside of school. Our summer Pastoral Pledge trips were a huge success – over 800 MA students visited a host of destinations across the north of England. I was privileged to go on the Year 10 trip and the students were immaculate – I was congratulated by the manager of the resort on the behaviour of Year 10.

For the first time, Sports Day was wet and yet, even in a heavy downpour, students competed with pride and their classmates roared them home. It was fantastic to see such determination and energy – despite the challenges of the weather. Our Duke of Edinburgh teams also braved the weather and completed their expeditions – an excellent addition to their college application forms. We opened our new toilet block – something the students have wanted for some time and over the summer our Fitness Gym was built, a fantastic, professional resource for Key Stage 4 students, who suggested the idea. We have improved numerous classrooms and continued to decorate and renovate across the Academy. To make Manchester magic, our students need a high quality, professional environment and I am so excited by the improvements we have made.

Finally, I travelled to London as we had been nominated for two national awards in the Education Business Awards final 2023. I was proud to attend to represent our school but didn't expect to win as we were up against some tough competition. It was amazing when they announced we had won the Leadership award and it was overwhelming to collect the trophy on behalf of all the students, staff and supporters of Manchester Academy. To have an award-winning school, in the heart of our community, is so important so we demonstrate the talent of our students and their families to the whole country.

We now have to do even better in the new academic year!

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#### **BEST EVER RESULTS**

Students and staff were celebrating after receiving our best ever GCSE results in August.

These excellent results build on our school's 'Good' Ofsted report at the beginning of this academic year, and our national Education Business Award win (page 5). Some of the Academy's highest achievers, securing a host of the highest 8 and 9 grades, included:

 $\cdot$  Hin Sum Yue (Hannah), who achieved eleven grade 9s and one grade 8, and is heading to Loreto College to study Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Maths at A Level;

- $\cdot$  Ogooluwa Oni, who achieved eight grade 9s and two grade 8s;
- Iman Iman, who achieved seven grade 9s, one grade 8 and two grade 7s.
  Mr Eldon, Principal of Manchester Academy, said:

"We are all incredibly proud of these strong GCSE results. Despite the challenges of COVID, our class of 2023 have made Manchester magic. 30% of the year group joined us after Year 7, 16% joined the Academy after Year 10 and many students learnt English during their school career with us. Yet the unity and hard work of the students has paid off."

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#### PASTORAL AWARD FINALISTS

Congratulations to our Family Liaison Officer Mr Adam who has been shortlisted as a finalist in the 2023 National Awards for Pastoral Care in Education, organised by NAPCE.

He has been nominated for his outstanding contribution to pastoral care at Manchester Academy.

Mr Adam is Manchester Academy's School Family Liaison Officer and provides a direct link between Parents/Carers whose first language is not English. He speaks fluent Somali and Arabic and is available in school on a daily basis to bridge that gap in communication.

There are more than 80% EAL students in school at Manchester Academy, and approximately 70 languages are spoken. The most prominent languages spoken are Somali, Arabic and Urdu.

During the period of the two national lockdowns, Mohammed Adam's work across our local community was of huge importance in terms of supporting families with food parcels, contact with other agencies and supporting the wider Safeguarding effort to ensure that students working remotely were engaging and remaining safe online.

Mr Adam has been invited to the presentation event on Friday 29th September at Worcestershire County Cricket Ground in Worcester, when the winners in each category will be announced and the prizes and certificates will be presented.














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#### ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES


