The aim of CEIAG at Manchester Academy is to help ensure that every young person has raised aspirations, they develop skills, behaviours and characteristics that will underpin success in education and employment. Manchester Academy aims to promote the best interests of the pupils by broadening horizons and empowering students with information on all options available to them to allow them to make informed realistic decisions at all key transition points in learning and work.

Manchester Academy will support all students to:

- Understand themselves and develop their skills (self-development)
- Research careers and opportunities (career exploration)
- Develop their own career plan (career management)

Manchester Academy will facilitate the development of the above by offering:

- A Careers Library where resources about career pathways, colleges, apprenticeships and university are available
- Careers and employment fairs
- A member of Academy staff who is available to answer questions and offer guidance
- Access to careers advisors to provide independent and impartial CEIAG
- Help and support when applying for college courses
- Help and support when applying for Apprenticeships
- Support to plan individual student's career pathways
- 'Taster Days' to try out new subjects at local colleges
- Subject specialists from colleges running curriculum tasters
- Apprenticeships information and support for Apprenticeship applications
- Information on the qualifications needed to get into university
- Information on the degree courses that are available locally and nationally
- The opportunity to meet undergraduates and talk to them about their courses
- Visits to local universities to learn more about degree courses
- Taster days at universities
- Information regarding employment opportunities that are available locally
- Detailed information of business sectors such as hospitality, engineering, construction or law
- Employers and specialists running curriculum taster sessions
- Taster days off site with businesses
